ELSA'S PROCESSIONAL TO THE CATHEDRAL

From The Opera "Lohengrin"

Transcribed By Richard Wagner

"ELSA'S PROCESSION TO THE CATHED RAL," with its medieval color and pageantry, prefaces her betrothal to Lohengren, mystic knight of the Holy Grail, come to deliver the people of Brabant - Antwerpfrom the Hungarian invader.

In the operatic presentation, large double chorus -representing the people of antwerp- add its song of solem praise to that of the orchestra. It is this music mystic, yet powerful, that we find Wagner striking out with those new and intense musical thoughts which we where to culminate in tristan, the ring, and parsifal. Not quite emancipated from the musical speech of his operatic contemporaries, one finds in the lohengrin score those unmistakable flights into musico-dramatic magnificence transcending all that preceded it in idion and musical adventure.
