GUEST SOLOIST - ROBERT NAGEL

Robert Nagel began his musical career at the age of eight. As a young cornet prodigy, he was guest soloist with the famous Armco Band, the U.S. Marine Band and many others. He studied trumpet and conducting with Dr. Frank Simon, renowned Sousa Band soloist; George Mager, first trumpet of the Boston Symphony under Koussevitsky; and Ernest Williams, well-known symphony and solo trumpeter. He studied composition with William Bergsma, Peter Mennin, Vincent Persichetti and Aaron Copland.

Mr. Nagel attended the Cincinnati Conservatory and the Juilliard School of Music, where he received his B.S. and M.S. degrees. Today he is an outstanding soloist and has premiered 30 solos during the past 18 years.

He is a faculty member of Yale University School of Music, a member of the artist-faculty of the Aspen Music Festival and Music School, and has taught at the Juilliard School of Music, Hofstra University and Rutgers University.

The composer of more than twenty-five original works, Mr. Nagel is a member and American Composers Alliance, has written articles for music magazines, has edited various brass studies, solos and ensemble pieces, and is president of Mentor Music, Inc., publisher of brass music.

Mr. Nagel is founder and director of the New York Brass Quintet, a group that has earned wide acclaim through radio and television, recordings and concert tours of Europe and North America.

Recognized by leading critics as one of today's most brilliant trumpet artists, he possesses the rare combination of teaching skill along with performing talents. Conductor, composer, and artist, he is also an educator. He has conducted clinics for public school teacher groups, private brass instructors, college music teachers, and high school and elementary students. His clinics cover embouchure, breath-control, intonation, articulation, fingering, sight-reading, style, musicianship, teaching materials, or other specialized subjects as requested by the music educator.

Mr. Nagel has performed clinics at schools and colleges throughout the country. He is also in demand and highly qualified as a stage band clinician, having played with such bands as Mitch Miller, Raymond Paige and Artie Shaw, and with New York musical show orchestras such as "West Side Story," "My Fair Lady," and "Sound of Music."

We are both proud and honored to have Robert Nagel appear as guest soloist with the Gettysburg Senior High School Band.
