GUEST CONDUCTOR

Mr. Robert G. Ziegler was the Gettysburg High School Band Director from 1951 to 1961. Mr. Ziegler was born in York County and graduated from Dallastown High School. His early musical interests were his Sunday School Orchestra and the Yoe Band. Upon completion of his Bachelor of Science degree from West Chester University, he spent three years in the military serving with the engineers in the China-Burma-India Theater. Following this, he completed his master's degree from Temple University. Prior to coming to Gettysburg in 1951, Mr. Ziegler taught instrumental and vocal music, grades 1-12, in the New Freedom-Glen Rock School System. He is a former President of the Pennsylvania Bandmasters Association and of the Adams County Community Concert Association. Mr. Ziegler retired from teaching music from Gettysburg in 1984.

EISENHOWER INAUGURATION

One of the highlights of going to school in the 1950's was playing in the band at the Gettysburg School System. For a very small fortunate group of students, we played many times for the President of the United State, Dwight D. Eisenhower. The President and First Lady (Mamie Eisenhower) had purchased a farm at Gettysburg in 1950. Captain Eisenhower had been stationed at Gettysburg in 1918 training the US Army Tank Corps. He and Mamie fell in love with the local community that included the Battlefield. When Eisenhower was elected to the White House in 1952, he and his wife continued to visit the farm as often as they could. The Senior High Band always greeted them as they would stop at the Square and greet hundreds of Gettysburg students. This greeting usually took place on a Friday. Schools closed many times and the students were escorted to the Square to wait for the President and First Lady to arrive. Band and students pictures were featured in national magazines and newspapers many times during the Eisenhower presidential years.

In 1956, President Eisenhower won a landslide victory in his re-election. He insisted the Gettysburg High School Band march in his 2nd Inaugural Parade on January 20, 1957. The director of the band was Robert G. Ziegler who went to work organizing the band trip to Washington DC. Coaches were reserved for the band members which numbered seventy-five strong. We loaded the busses very early in the morning on January 20th and headed for Washington. Mr. Zeigler warned us to dress warmly because the temperatures were in the low 20s for the parade. Many members wore two pairs of long underwear and still froze. The parade down Pennsylvania Avenue was very long. As the band marched by the Presidential reviewing stand, we all looked out of the corner of our eyes to get a glimpse of the Eisenhowers. As I looked at the President, I noticed that he stood up and saluted us as we passed the stand. What a moment in the life of a 9th grader. It is a moment and event no members of the band ever forgot. Gettysburg High School Band became one of two Pennsylvania high school bands to march in a presidential inauguration.
