The members of the quartet are: Ben Sneeringer, Don Myers, Ed Kuhn, and Bill Foreman.

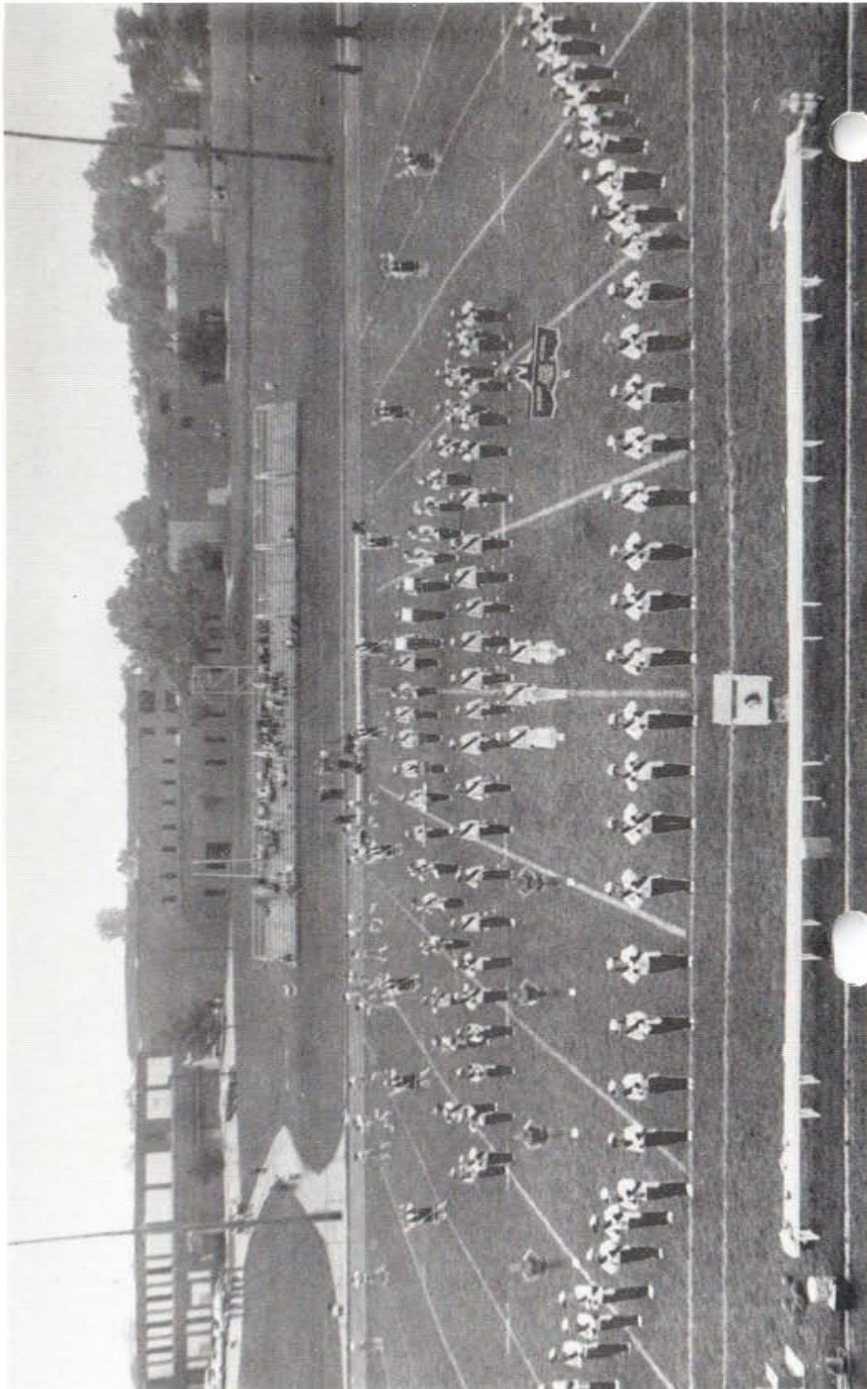
The ZEMBO HIGHLANDERS

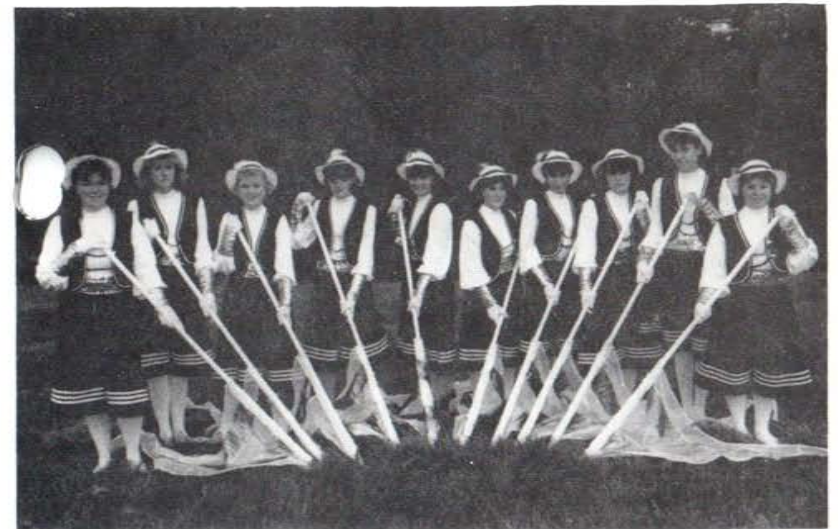
